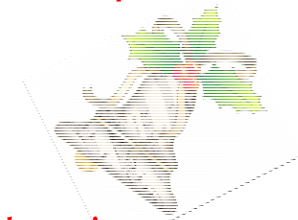
Super Seniors Christmas Caroling
